It causes mental anguish and impacts on one's ability to carry out eventhe simplest everyday tasks, with sometimes devastating consequences for relationships with family and friends and the ability to earn a living. At worst, depression can lead to suicide, now the second leading cause of death among younger generation. Yet, depression can be prevented and treated. A better understanding of what depression is, and how it can be prevented and treated, will help to reduce the stigma associated with the condition, and lead to more people seeking help. So this conference is for everyone, whatever the age, sex, or social status. The WHO has chosen to pay particular attention to three groups that are disproportionally affected: adolescents and young adults, women of childbearing age and older adults.



Poster size (2x3 feet). Both Scientific and Concept posters are welcome. No Accessories will be provided for display of Poster.




