3. The abstract must include clear indication of topic, purpose of research, methodology, major result, implication, key words and references.
4. Selected entrants should submit their full paper in PDF format along with power point presentation by 15th May 2019.
5. Font 'Calibri', Font size '12', spacing '1.5'
6. Full paper should not be more than 2000 to 2500 words .
7. Time limit for paper presentation is 5+2 minutes.
8. Poster must be as JPG / PNG / JPEG by 20th April 2019.
9. Best paper and poster will be awarded.
10. Papers can be submitted by email to halocon.aj@gmail.com on or before 10th June 2019.
11. Slogan must be concise and in not more than 15 to 20 words.
12. Slogan can be typed or neatly hand written in English based on the theme of the conference and submitted by 20th April 2019.
13. Judges decision is final.
