CIRCULAR


Sub: Guidelines for effecting Migration Transfer for the year 2017-18.

As per MCI amendment notification dated: 15-02-2012, clause 6(1) (2) states that Migration of students from one college to another is permissible only if both the colleges are recognized by Central Government under section 11(2) the IMC Act 1956.

Further as per Clause 6(1)(4) the office of Director of Medical Education will take a final decision in the matter as to whether or not to allow migration in accordance with the provisions of these regulations and communicate the same to the applicant student within a period of One month from the date of receipt of the request for migration.

1. Recognized Medical Colleges should publish the number of seats available for Migration Transfer in their respective website under intimation to this office. The number of seats available for Migration Transfer subject to the condition that it shall not exceed 5% of the sanctioned annual intake capacity of the college.
2. Recognized Medical colleges wherein the students have opted for out of the Institution and all the medical colleges wherein the students have opted to come into the Institution shall invite applications for Migration Transfer from interested candidates.
3. The Medical Colleges from where the student is opting out and the receiving Medical College where the student is opting to come in shall prepare a merit list of all applicants who have applied for Migration Transfer.
4. The Medical Colleges shall invite the migration transfer application till 6.10.2017
5. Issue of NOC shall commence from 7.10.2017 onwards.
6. Students shall receive No Objection Certificate in Order of merit secured in 1st MBBS examinations from outgoing Medical College and receiving Medical College subject to the condition that Migration Transfer in both the outgoing and receiving Medical Colleges is restricted to 5% of the annual sanctioned in the capacity of college by 13.10.2017.
7. The Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences is requested to issue "No Objection Certificate" to eligible candidates.

8. The students possessing No Objection Certificates from the outgoing Medical College, receiving Medical College and RGUHS shall apply in prescribed format, along with undertaking and original No Objection Certificates to the Director of Medical Education as on or before 13.10.2017.
9. The Director of Medical Education will in turn refer these students to Medical Board whenever necessary.
10. The Medical Board shall give its opinion regarding eligibility for migration transfer.
11. The Directorate of Medical Education will issue Migration Orders to eligible candidates on or before 8.11.2017.
12. Such of the students who have been given Migration Orders shall report to receiving Medical College by 13.11.2017.
13. Wide Publicity shall be given to all the students seeking Migration Transfer about the schedule by putting up the circular in all the Institutional website and Notice Boards, to ensure transparency and provide equal opportunity to all meritorious candidates.
14. All Migration transfers are effect as per the existing Medical Council of India rules and regulations.
15. A fresh Government order in this regard will be issued soon. Such transfers are subject to final approval by Medical Council of India.

MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA

AMENDMENT NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 20th October, 2008

No. MCI-34(41)/2008-Med./29527 - In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956), the Medical Council of India with the previous approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations to further amend the Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997, namely:-

1. These Regulations may be called the "Regulations on Graduate Medical Education (Amendment), 2008."

2. In the Regulations on Graduate Medical Education, 1997, the following additions / modifications / deletions / substitutions, shall be as indicated therein:-

3. Clause 6(1) under heading "Migration/Transfer" shall be substituted as under:

"(1) Migration of students from one medical college to another medical college in India shall be granted only in exceptional cases to the most deserving among the applicants for good and sufficient reasons and not on routine grounds. The number of students migrating to/from any one medical college shall be kept to the minimum which shall in any case not exceed the limit of 5% of its sanctioned intake in one academic year. There shall be no migration on any ground from one medical college to another located in the same city.

(2) Migration of students from one College to another is permissible only if both the colleges are recognised by the Central Government under section 11(2) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and further subject to the condition that it shall not result in increase in the sanctioned intake capacity for the academic year concerned in respect of the receiving medical college.

(3) The applicant candidate shall be eligible to apply for migration only after qualifying in the first professional MBBS examination. Migration during clinical course of study shall not be allowed on any ground.

(4) For the purpose of migration, an applicant candidate shall first obtain 'No Objection Certificates' from the college where he is studying for the present, the University to which it is affiliated to, the college to which migration is sought and the University to which that college is affiliated to. He shall submit his application for migration within a period of one month of passing (declaration of results) of the first professional MBBS examination alongwith the said 'No Objection Certificates' to the Director, Medical Education of the State where the College/Institutions including Deemed Universities to which migration is sought is situated or to the Head of the Institution in case migration is sought to a Central Government institution. The Director, Medical Education of the State concerned or the Head of the Central Government institution, as the case may be, shall take a final decision in the matter as to whether or not to allow migration in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations and communicate the same to the applicant student within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the request for migration.
